Our curriculum aspires to have creativity at its core. We celebrate creative talents and oracy through access to drama throughout the whole curriculum alongside singing, choirs, art clubs, and theatre shows. We foster presentational speaking in all its forms and provide opportunities to build, create, invent and experiment using imagined and real-life situations.





We provide opportunities to develop oracy to ensure clear, concise communication appropriate for task, person and place. We provide purposeful opportunities for talk and authentic audiences so that children develop confidence to articulate and debate.







Early Years

We understand each child has different needs, interests, experiences, knowledge and learning styles, and we tailor learning opportunities to encourage these needs.

The learning topics within our nursery at Furzeham reflect our children's interests and experiences and use our local coastal community and heritage.

We are trusted to ensure all our early years children feel safe and secure to explore and experiment in order to learn and develop. Learning opportunities are provided through both child- and adult-initiated activities using both the indoor and outdoor environments, ensuring challenge, enquiry and support to encourage development in all areas.









Thinking Schools

The Thinking Schools Academy Trust is a family of schools that work together to transform the life chances of all our children and young people. We share a common mission to nurture successful young people who are confident and can think and act independently.

Students are equipped with a bank of Thinking Tools designed to prepare them for a range of scenarios, dilemmas and circumstances that they may face in life as part of modern society. The use of these Tools in our curriculum is supported by scientific and metacognitive research, and Pupils are encouraged to apply their tools independently and use them to unlock new ideas. Our Thinking Tools include: Thinking Maps, De Bono's Thinking Hats and Art Costa's Habits of Mind. These tools are used consistently across all areas of our curriculum

and support our students tremendously in their learning and personal growth.

The concept of 'Being your Best Self' is also at the heart of our approach to learning at the Thinking School. Pupils are encouraged to strive to be and achieve their best, and are given multiple opportunities to reflect on their learning and work on their personal development.







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
