History is our driver subject this term. We will be learning all about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age and the significant features of each period including tools and weapons, everyday life, settlements and beliefs and the reasons why the period ended. We will be visiting Kents Cavern and Brixham Museum to learn about our prehistoric ancestors, how they lived and survived in our local area and looking at the artefacts that have been found locally. We will also be learning about Stonehenge and Cheddar Man.	We will be developing our writing through looking at different genres, including: narratives, recounts, chronological reports and poetry. We will be developing our reading skills through a range of fiction and nonfiction texts in Whole Class Reading, sharing a Class Story for pleasure and working from model texts in our writing units. We will be learning a range of spelling rules as well as statutory words which will then be assessed regularly.	We will be developing our understanding of place value, by reading, writing, comparing and ordering 4-digit numbers up to 10,000. We will be learning how to add and subtract numbers mentally. We will also be continuing to use formal column methods for addition and subtraction.	We will be learning different geographical skills including locating countries on maps, human and physical features, using four-figure grid references and compass points. We will learn about the different layers of the Earth, including plate tectonics and their potential effects on the Earth's surface.	We will be deepening our understanding of colour theory and learning about complementary, tertiary and analogous colours and discussing how they are used in different works of art; as well as developing our own colour mixing skills. We will also make clay pinch pots linked to Bell Beaker pottery.
