<p>History is our driver subject this term. We will be learning all about the causes of the First and Second World Wars and which nations were involved. We will focus on how weaponry, warfare and technology significantly changed over both wars. We will also investigate how key events and battles changed the outcome of both World Wars and how life became different for those citizens left behind.</p>	<p>We will be developing our writing through:</p> <p>Recount – Letters from the Lighthouse</p> <p>Descriptive paragraph – Beyond the Lines</p> <p>War Poetry</p> <p>Instructions – How to build an Anderson Shelter</p> <p>Persuasive Letter – Assistance Dogs in Schools</p>	<p>Place Value – read and write numbers to 10,000,000, negative numbers, rounding, ordering.</p> <p>The Four Operations – factors primes and multiples, square numbers, long multiplication and division, order of operations</p> <p>Fractions – Equivalent fractions on a number line and simplifying, comparing and ordering, the four operations, fractions of an amount.</p>	<p>The Circulatory System teaches us about the role and main parts of the heart as well as its structure. We look in detail at blood, structure and function, including blood vessels. We also measure heart rate to prove a hypothesis. By focusing on our personal health we look at the dangers of nicotine as well as illegal drugs and how they can affect our bodies</p>	<p>Tints, Tones and Shades teaches children about colour theory by studying the colour wheel and exploring mixing tints, shades and tones.</p> <p>War and Peace artwork using different media. Children use a variety of symbols that represent war and peace that links to our World War topic.</p>
