Your child has already had some experience of the SATs papers (last term's assessments) and they will continue to do so this term as well. Intervention groups start in the mornings for those children who are not yet working at the expected standard.

Our topic this term is "Frozen Kingdoms". We will be focusing on the different climatic zones of the Arctic and Antarctic and the animals that live there, researching their habitat and how they have evolved to survive in varying conditions.
